The best part of what I'm going to tell you is that, we are now very much ready to bring out the **FUNDS** with the initial use of the Founder's assets in CHINA. As we all know, CHINA's economy has been very good for the last couple of years. In fact I was invited last November of 2013 to a Table Top Meeting in Hong Kong by a Governor Inspector General of an International Organization for Economic Development recognized by the United Nations, to facilitate the redemption with the committee assigned by the Chinese Government, one of the CHINA assets of the Founder of HMF Abba Martin Eddy Hornido Tirwatadinata. A Liberty Bond (CHINA) showed and linked to my LETTER, which was verified as REAL. I received also several communications from bankers here in California and Switzerland, their interest to connect me with some buyers from around the globe to buy this Liberty Bond asset of the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION.

My only concern in this situation is how are we going to spend the interests from the proceeds? IF we (the Founder and I) decide to go with the redemption process since the Government of China (since 2006) would like to give up all their US Treasury Notes in exchange of the Founder's assets in China. The interests alone once the proceeds are placed in an investment program will be in the hundreds of billions of dollars. For just this one particular Bond linked to my LETTER, an estimated amount of 75-100Billion (USD) dollars was given. We need to prepare the "baskets" / projects that will provide services and create jobs in collaboration with the different States and Local Government such as with your state or city.

Our "HMF MODEL PROJECT" is the H. MARTIN Global Community Center (plus the name of your city or community), an "HMF Humanitarian Services Mall" where different humanitarian agencies will be housed inside. We need your cooperation to spread the good news to the different City Mayors and Council Members, so they can plan and prepare this MODEL PROJECT that will provide the different services and create employment opportunities in collaboration with existing humanitarian agencies and charitable organizations already licensed to operate. Everyone involved from the Project Leaders, Administrative Staff and Volunteers will receive honorarium / salary with complete benefits. All the State and Local Government's salary and benefits will also be augmented.

The H. MARTIN FOUNDATION CANNOT START to bring out the FUNDS when PROJECTS are NOT ready, because these funds will just be sitting in the banks. When this happens, the bankers will be the one to use these funds which is what is happening currently in our economy. The bankers opted to invest the funds created through Quantitative Easing, in commodities such as corn, sugar etc. for fast and higher returns. This causes the increase in prices of products for the consumers or decrease in the packaging of end-products for the people just to maintain the price that is affordable. The result has a negative impact on the people, which is the reason why the voice of the people is also needed NOW, to CLAMOR the Government of the United States to collaborate for the establishment of the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION Far East Humanitarian Services USA. for the upliftment of their standard of living.

To hasten the preparation of the PROJECTS and the PEOPLE, thus creating many employment opportunities and availability of humanitarian services all over the United States, "WE NEED THE VOICE OF THE PEOPLE" to CLAMOR the Government of the United States of America, to COLLABORATE with the H. What: H. MARTIN FOUNDATION Far East Humanitarian Services ("HMF")
Collaboration with the Local Government and Project Leaders

PURPOSE: To get the cooperation of the Local Government in the creation and development of the "Preliminary HMF Humanitarian Collaborative Agreement", commonly known as a Memorandum of Understanding that will start-up the relationship between the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION Far East Humanitarian Services and the Local Government in the eventual realization of the HMF MODEL CITY PROJECTS and HMF MODEL COUNTY PROJECTS.

<u>MISSION</u>: To help uplift the standard of living of the American people through the FUNDING by the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION of programs and projects that will <u>provide services and create jobs</u> that is very much needed now by the people.

The HMF FUNDING is **NOT** a loan or a government grant or a donation. The FUNDS are privately owned and is clean, clear and of non-criminal origin, very much recognized by the highest monetary authorities and the United States Government. HMF will not "reinvent the wheel". HMF will use the current infrastructure in the implementation of the programs and projects, to immediately alleviate the people's burden and uplift the standard of living of the people. In doing so, **in Collaboration with the Local Government**, HMF is ready to provide 100% FUNDING with the following considerations:

- 1. HMF will consider all existing projects for 100% funding, especially projects that will directly benefit the people. The Local Government has to identify the projects of utmost importance or priority for the people or the city.
- 2. In some instances, acquisition by HMF may take place, but the management and existing employees will remain. Some changes may occur such as the following to achieve the Founder's Vision, "LIFE IN ITS FULLNESS" for the people.
 - a. <u>Better benefits</u> for existing employees such as free medical, dental and vision insurance. Free Childcare/Before and After School Programs and Complete Scholarship Programs for immediate family members. <u>One has to work to receive all these benefits to encourage everybody to get off of welfare.</u>
 - b. **Perpetual funding** as long as "Management" stays in alignment with the Vision and Mission of the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION.
 - i. Project-holders can now expand what they are currently doing and look "outside of the box" to make their GOD-given Vision and dreams a reality.
 - ii. Project-holders can now be focused on providing good quality services and not after profit or raising funds for non-profit.
 - iii. Better ambience and working environment for everyone, etc.

Reasons why HMF has to do the acquisition:

- c. 100% FUNDING by H. MARTIN FOUNDATION. <u>To align the purpose of the project to the Vision and Mission of the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION</u>.
- d. In adherence to the principle of accountability even to itself, <u>H. MARTIN</u>

 FOUNDATION is liable and subject to audit by a reputable accounting group which is recognized by the Federal Reserve Regulatory Board.
- 3. The Local Government will gather all important projects and corresponding budgets valuable to the development of the city, to meet the needs of the people.
- 4. The Local Government to gather all Project Leaders to lead in the implementation of Programs and Projects.
- 5. H. MARTIN FOUNDATION together with the Local Government will provide Humanitarian Seminars in relation to the Mission and Vision of H. MARTIN FOUNDATION.
- 6. In collaboration with the Local Government and Project Leaders, H. MARTIN FOUNDATION would like to create a Funding Mechanism that will be streamlined where payments are made on a timely basis.
- 7. In collaboration with the Local Government and Project Leaders, HMF would like to have an efficient process where requests for goods and services will be maintained at the highest level.
- 8. In collaboration with the Local Government and Project Leaders, HMF would like to structure a procedure that will monitor the recipient's course of action in order to maintain the highest standard of operations and accounting principles.

9. With the extra work and efforts that the Local Government will do to put the Projects and Project Leaders together, the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION is ready also to augment the current salary and benefits of all the Mayors, Councilmen and Leaders in position (in the form of HMF honorarium and benefits), especially those who will actively involve themselves in achieving the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION's goals and objectives.

10. HMF Requirements From Project Holders:

- a. All Project holders and members must attend HMF Humanitarian Seminars in order to familiarize with the Vision and Mission of the Foundation.
- b. To adhere to the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.
- c. To be audited at any time by an external accredited accounting firm once the funding process begins.
- d. Agrees not to receive any outside and/or additional funding on projects that is 100% funded by HMF. NO co-mingling of funds.
- e. Agrees not to shift any allocated funds from one project to another.
- f. To submit a quarterly progress report for the purpose of accountability.
- g. Must create a "Complete Model Project" that will serve as a "cookie cutter type of project to be implemented all over United States and globally. This can be achieved by collaborating with other organizations, entities, agencies that have similar or same like projects.
- h. Agrees to consider ideas from other existing entities/agencies that have similar or same like projects and the decision-making process must be based on consensus and in alignment with HMF Management/Vision.
- i. Agrees that all intangible and tangible assets such as "collaborative intellectual properties", land and buildings, machinery and equipment, furniture and fixture, supplies, etc. must be approved, acquired and purchased by the H. MARTIN FOUNDATION, and shall remain the sole property of H. MARTIN FOUNDATION.
- j. Any monetary gain/profit from projects funded by HMF will be returned to the general funds of HMF for expansion of same or other projects, and to improve the benefits of the people working on the projects.

11. What to Expect from HMF:

- a. Provide Humanitarian Seminars relating to the Mission and Vision of HMF.
- b. Create a proposed Funding Mechanism that will be streamlined where payments are made on a timely basis.
- c. Provide a proposed efficient process where requests for goods and services will be maintained at the highest level.
- d. Structure a proposed procedure that will monitor the recipient's standard course of action in order to maintain the highest standard of operations.
- e. Conduct unannounced project site visits during the implementation of projects.
- 12. HMF is open to any proposal or suggestions by the Local Government to make this Collaboration a success. Thank you!
