The recent launch of the website and social media reminds us of a pilot's experience he shared with us sometime ago. He talked about what pilots call "the point of no return". That's about the halfway point from take-off to landing.

Using the flight from Los Angeles to Hawaii as an example, the six plus-hour flight is over the pacific ocean the entire time. Without an airport or airstrip to land on in the event of an emergency, one has to make sure that everything is in working order at take-off. The does not only apply to the airplane but the pilot as

The small Learjet plane he flew had an inadequate bathroom. He has to use the bathroom at the airport before take-off, and even avoid drinking coffee during the flight since he had a one and a half hour bladder. The initial part of the flight is the only opportunity to determine the flight would be fine and go on, or to detect any problems and return.

At the point of no return, the pilot must determine if he'll commit to continue or abort the flight. Once the pilot commits, then no matter what happens on the other part of the flight, the pilot has to keep going forward because he's past the point of no return where he can safely return to his point of departure. He must continue to the destination airport or ditch in the ocean. We do not ditch anywhere, but press on to the goal.

We at HMF have crossed the point of no return for this mission. We have committed even before the website launch that we're all set, pilot, crew, fuel and plane. This is it! We have our destination in mind and we're in touch with that control tower. Dear friends, we've come this far by FAITH and we're going all the way because the time for GOD to favor us has come.
